The European Association of Israel Studies (EAIS) is pleased to announce its fourth graduate workshop in Israel Studies, to be held online on Monday 14 June from 1pm to 6pm (UTC) time.

The workshop seeks graduate students from all academic disciplines whose doctoral dissertations engage with the study of Israel. The workshop looks to provide a forum where students can raise and discuss any methodological, theoretical, practical, and ethical issues arising from their study of Israel. Presenters are encouraged to explain the nature of their research, any relevant hypotheses or research questions, and any proposed methodological and/or theoretical frameworks used.

This year, due to its extraordinary **online nature**, the workshop will be limited to two 90-minute sessions of student presentations, and one 60-minute session, led by the workshop organisers, that will focus on the 'career' side of PhD study.

The themes will this year likewise be limited to **History** (session One) and **Politics** (session Two).
